The Voyage of Mandir of Madison

Almighty Supreme God is formless. Though he is omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent, we need a symbolic home, a seat and a body for God. Such a thing is a temple, a structure designed to bring humans closer to the Lord.

The Agrawal family, in Madison, WI, initiated Hindu religious and cultural programs in a local church in 2006. Seeing the extended participation of the locals, they initiated Mandir of Madison and purchased property in Burke, Sun Prairie in 2007.

Ganapati, the best known and most worshipped deity of Hindu pantheon was consecrated in this small premise in 2008. 2009 was a great start for the temple- Hired first local priest, completed the community hall, external building signage, built main mandir hall outdoor landscaping, acquired conditional county permits, grand Prana Pratishthapana (idol consecration) ceremony of ten main deities. With generous support from the community, the temple grew and expanded its religious stronghold by pratishthapana of other deities. In 2010 Shivaling idol, in 2011 Shri Navgrahapratishtha, in 2012 Shri Saibaba pratishtha, in 2013 Shri Ayyappa Swamipratishtha, in 2014 Shri SatyaNarayana Swami pratishtha, in 2015 Shri Balaji pratishtha and in 2017 Shri Jagannath ji murthypratishtha. Biggest ceremony by the temple was in 2018 as they celebrated Jaganath Rath Yatra and Balaji Rath Yathra. 2019 was an excellent year for temple by being a part of a Multicultural Fair in Sun Prairie.

Few more Achievements by Mandir:

Lifetime permit for the Mandir facility and operations at the present location.

Groundbreaking ceremony in August 2017 for our new Mandir building (Future state)

Upgraded the current mandir facility by adding a third area (kitchen area)

With God's grace and valuable support from our beloved devotees, we hope to construct a formal Mandir in upcoming years and a proper parking area soon. As we all know 2020 was a difficult year all over the world due to covid-19, Mandir was open to people for 6 months with limited time with limited activities
